#### Beat the Rush!

A MESSAGE FROM NURSE WHITNEY In order to attend classes in Fall 2022, all incoming 7th graders are required by law to have proof of a whooping cough booster ('Tdap') shot, or file a Medical Waiver. Most students will only need to receive the Tdap booster. However, any student with a personal or religious belief waiver on file for any shots will need to obtain the shots waived or get a Medical Waiver from their physician. Exemptions based on personal beliefs are no longer an option for the shots that are required for entry into childcare or school in California.

#### **Classroom Volunteers**

Any person wishing to volunteer on a regular, on going basis, more than thirty minutes a week, will need the following items completed before beginning volunteer services;

- 1. Approved Volunteer Application (Applications are available in the school office)
- 2. Proof of negative TB (tuberculosis test)
- 3. Fingerprint Clearance (live scan) \*\*This must be submitted by the district.\*\*

#### **Aeries Parent Portal**

The Aeries Parent Portal can be used to check student attendance and grades (for 5th-8th). Here are step-by-step directions to get there:

- Go to www.evergreenusd.org
- Click on-community-parent resources-Aeries link parent portal. You will need your email address attached to your student's account.
- If you need to reset your password, click on "Forgot Password" (Do this to setup an account as well).
- A screen will pop up to enter your email, this email must be the one the school has on record.
- Enter your email address and hit next.
- Then check your email for a link to reset your password.
