## Aeries Parent Portal

The Aeries Parent Portal can be used to check student attendance for all grade levels and check grades and missing assignments for 5th-8th grades

Here are step-by-step directions to get there:

- Go to [www.evergreenusd.org](http://www.evergreenusd.org)
- Click on-community-parent resources-Aeries link parent portal. You will need your email address attached to your student's account.
- If you need to reset your password, click on "Forgot Password" (Do this to setup an account as well)
- A screen will pop up to enter your email, this email must be the one the school has on record.
- Enter your email address and hit next.
- Then check your email for a link to reset your password.

Six persons	\$7,283.04
Seven persons	\$8,207.38
Eight persons	\$9,131.71
Add \$924.33 each person over 8	

Income is **GROSS** monthly income, not **NET**.  
**ALL INCOME MUST BE REPORTED.**

Rules for eligibility and participation in the donated commodity program  
are the same for everyone without regard to race, color, age, sex,  
national origin, handicap, religious persuasion or sexual preference.  
Self certification that the recipient's income is within the program's  
guidelines is necessary. Must give a physical address.

**PLEASE bring your own recycle bags and carts for food.**
